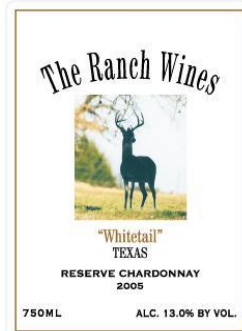

Lone Star International Wine Competition - RESULTS

Lone Star Wine Cellars Enters Four Wines - Lone Star Wine Cellars Takes Home Four Medals



Well the results are in and your very own Lone Star Wine Cellars (Triple "R" Ranch and Winery and Wales Manor) entered four wines in Texas' largest and most prestigious wine competition this year and **MEDAILED WITH ALL FOUR**. Wineries from all over the state of Texas, as well as all over the country and even internationally, participated in the Lone Star International Wine Competition, which was held this year July 6th. Ron Ross of the Triple "R" Ranch and Winery (The Ranch Wines) entered his 04 "Big Red" Cabernet Sauvignon, his (not yet released) 05 Whitetail Chardonnay, and his 05 Blackbuck Antelope Merlot. John Wales of Wales Manor entered his newly released Blanc du Bois Reserve. In two of the most competitive categories, the Cabernet Sauvignon and the Chardonnay, The Ranch Wines took 2nd best wine in Texas with Silver Medals while the Merlot and the Blanc du Bois took third best wine in Texas with Bronze metals. Not a bad day's work.

Surprise! Surprise! Guess what's coming this time in the Wine Club. Unless you have otherwise requested, you will be receiving the "not yet released" Award Winning 2005 Whitetail Chardonnay from The Ranch Wines. Hope you enjoy it as much as the judges did.

Also, grab a picnic basket, head for the countryside and have a real outing at Wales Manor Vineyard and Winery with the Wales Manor 2006 Picnic Red Meritage. Wales Manor offers a beautiful outdoor setting for a relaxing day. You can wonder around the vineyards, see the huge wine tanks and relax on the patio with a bottle of Picnic Meritage. Take 380 East out of McKinney a mile or so to 1827. Turn left and go to County Road 408. Follow 408 till you come to a vineyard on your right. You're there. Wales Manor is open Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
