The common belief that swirling your wine rapidly prior to tasting it will help aerate it and bring out the flavors, is a misconception. Swirling it rapidly is what is referred to as "Volatilizing the Esters". In other words, you are combining the compounds and releasing the alcohol. To enjoy a single glass of wine without decanting an entire bottle, simply tilt your glass to the side so the wine is nearly to the rim and roll gently. This will aerate the wine sufficiently without disturbing the compounds thereby allowing you to enjoy the full body and
