For those who enjoy delving a little deeper, join us at Lone Star Wine Cellars for a great learning experience; a class on “Wines of the World” with International Guild Certified Sommelier, Tim Goertz, beginning in September. In 8 sessions you will explore the major wine producing regions of the world....France, Italy, Spain, North America, South America, Australia and New Zealand. You’ll be able to identify the major growing areas within the regions and the major varietals produced. Included in each class will be tastings of wines from these regions as well as flavor profiles of the various varietals produced and how to identify them.

The text for this class will be “World Atlas of Wine” (7<sup>th</sup> ed.) by Jancis Robinson and Hugh Johnson, both highly acclaimed Masters of Wine. Additionally there will be informative class handouts such as an aroma wheel and a grape character summation chart as well as detailed colored charts from major wine appellations.
