**Winemaker Personal Notes:**

This 100 percent Texas-grown Sangiovese displays a day-bright cherry color  
in the glass with a slight garnet hue on the rim. The Nose carries aromas of  
cherry, berry and dried cranberry followed by a slight earthiness that lingers  
delicately on the back end. On the palate, this light-bodied red offers a zesty  
acidity with fresh red fruit flavors flowing through mid-palate followed by a  
clean and lively finish. The balance of this wine demonstrates an ability to pair  
easily with a variety of cuisines and its finesse allows this wine ample room  
to be consumed on its own. Best between two and three years.
