The 2006 Longhorn Shiraz has a fruit basket nose of red and blue fruits followed by an intense aroma of black cherries and blueberries, intermixed with a subtle pepper spice. On the palate this refreshing Shiraz is bursting with blueberries and ripe sweet plums. Balanced acidity, backed by smooth fruit tannins lead to an easy drinking wine.
