 Aroma: Melon, apple, apricot, pear and a faint hint of orange peel.
 Clarity: Day bright

Winemaker Personal Notes:
White Fallow displays a nose of intense red apple, pear, apricot and melon structured on a medium-bodied frame. The Chenin Blanc (43%) flavors of melon, apricot and crème fraiche, backed by its high acidity, compliment the Chardonnay (34%) flavor of apple and pear. The Sauvignon Blanc & Viognier round out the aromatics and body with firm acidity and a full mouthfeel. A great wine to pair with a fish entre.
